We have recently appointed an interim ground maintenance contractor, World Wide Plants, to care for the pockets of colour and greenery across the estate. This includes cutting grass in the communal areas during summer and pruning shrubs in the autumn. We hope by spring you will notice an improvement and the estate will soon be bursting with colour.

NEED A REPAIR?

Before you report a repair for your home please check to see who is responsible for fixing the problem as some minor repairs are your responsibility, while most other issues are down to us or Hackney Council to fix.

- If you need to report an emergency repair out of office hours please call **020 8356 3691**.

We will refer you on to Hackney Council if the repair falls under the Council's responsibility.

If you are a leaseholder you are responsible for repairs in your home but please get in touch to report an issue with a communal area in your block.

HOW LONG WILL MY REPAIR TAKE?

Repairs aim to be completed with certain timescales:



Emergency - within 24 hours. Emergency repairs where the delay might seriously put your possessions at risk or cause serious inconvenience.



Urgent - within 7 days. Urgent jobs are those where delays might cause gradual damage to the property or your possessions.



Routine within 28 days. All other repairs under our responsibility.



Keeping your neighbourhood clean and safe is our top priority and we carry out regular estate inspections to ensure standards are maintained. If you would like to join an inspection to point out any local issues or concerns, please look out for your invite or get in touch to find out when the next walkabout will take place.

ARE YOU COVERED?

Look around your home, could you afford to replace all your belongings if they were damaged, lost or destroyed?

No one knows when disaster may strike so we strongly advise you to take out contents insurance to cover the cost of your personal possessions in the event of a fire, flood, act of vandalism or crime.

FIRE SAFETY

E-bikes and e-scooters are increasingly popular but fire and rescue services are reporting an alarming increase in the number of fires caused by their lithium-ion batteries overheating or even exploding.

If you own an e-bike or e-scooter:

- Always use the official charger that came with your product.
- Never leave it charging while you are asleep or away from home.
- Never charge or store your vehicle in communal areas or stairwells (if you do it will be removed).
